

## Summer Reading 2010-2011

### Grade 1

Select any 3 books, and complete a handout on each. Summer reading will not result in a grade. At least 3 books must be read and 3 handouts completed to participate in the reward party. All students participating in the reward party will also be entered into the gift certificate drawing. Each additional book read and handout completed results in an additional entry in the drawing. Please encourage your children to read books that are appropriate for their grade level.

### Grade 2

Select any 3 AR books **at or above the first grade level** (1.0 or above), and complete a handout on each. Summer reading will not result in a grade. At least 3 books must be read and 3 handouts completed to participate in the reward party. All students participating in the reward party will also be entered into the gift certificate drawing. Each additional book read and handout completed results in an additional entry in the drawing. Also, each student scoring above 85% on their first AR test receives an additional entry in the drawing.

### Grade 3

Select any 3 AR books **at or above the second grade level** (2.0 or above), and complete a handout on each. Summer reading will not result in a grade. At least 3 books must be read and 3 handouts completed to participate in the reward party. All students participating in the reward party will also be entered into the gift certificate drawing. Each additional book read and handout completed results in an additional entry in the drawing. Also, each student scoring above 85% on their first AR test receives an additional entry in the drawing.

### Grade 4

Select one AR book **at or above the third grade level** (3.0 or above). Write a book report (see Book Report Guidelines) on the selected book. This report will count as one homework grade.

Participation in the reward party requires that at least 2 AR books at or above the assigned grade level are read and at least 2 book reports are completed (see Book Report Guidelines). All students participating in the reward party will also be entered into the gift certificate drawing. Each additional book read and book report completed results in an additional entry in the drawing. Also, each student scoring above 85% on their first AR test receives an additional entry in the drawing.

### Grade 5

Select one AR book **at or above the fourth grade level** (4.0 or above). Write a book report (see Book Report Guidelines) on the book; this report will comprise 80% of the summer reading grade. Take the AR test on the selected book; the score on this test will comprise the other 20% of the summer reading grade. Summer reading will count as one quiz grade.

Participation in the reward party requires that at least 2 AR books at or above the assigned grade level are read and at least 2 book reports are completed (see Book Report Guidelines). All students participating in the reward party will also be entered into the gift certificate drawing. Each additional book read and book report completed results in an additional entry in the drawing. Also, each student scoring above 85% on their first AR test receives an additional entry in the drawing.

### Grades 6-7

Select one AR book **at or above the specified grade level** (4.0 or above for 6<sup>th</sup> grade; 5.0 or above for 7<sup>th</sup> grade). Write a book report (see Book Report Guidelines); this report will comprise 80% of the summer reading grade. Take the AR test on the selected book; the score on this test will comprise the other 20% of the summer reading grade. Summer reading will count as one test grade.

Participation in the reward party requires that at least 2 AR books at or above the assigned grade level are read and at least 2 book reports are completed (See Book Report Guidelines). All students participating in the reward party will also be entered into the gift certificate drawing. Each additional book read and book report completed results in an additional entry in the drawing. Also, each student scoring above 85% on their first AR test receives an additional entry in the drawing.

#### **How to determine whether or not a book is an AR book and its level:**

Go to [http://www.renlearn.com/store/quiz\\_home.asp](http://www.renlearn.com/store/quiz_home.asp), and type the book's title into the search box. An AR book title will appear as a result of the search, and its level will be displayed next to it.
