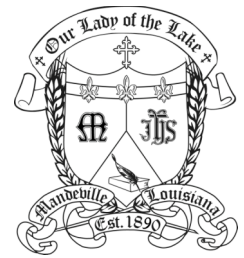

**Office Notes:** Parents – We need your help! Please make sure that notes sent to the office regarding your child are on a full size sheet of paper, written in blue or black ink, and include the following: child's name (first and last), homeroom, parent name and phone number, bus number or name of person picking up your child. Please be specific! Thanks for your help.

**Early Check Out Procedure:** We ask that you make all necessary appointments for your child after school hours. ## **Parish Affiliation Categories and Definitions**

At this time of the year, questions arise regarding how Parish Affiliation Status is determined when you are registering or re-registering your child for the 2010-2011 school year. Each individual Parish determines its guidelines for defining whether or not a family is considered Registered, Active, Supporting. The categories and their definitions are below.

**Accumulation of dollars is based on the calendar year which will be January 1, 2009 through December 31, 2009.** All donations must be mailed or sent directly to the Parish Life Center. *Please do not send donations through the school.* If you have questions concerning your status, please call Terry in the church office at 626-5671, ext.112 or e-mail her at [terry@ollparish.info](mailto:terry@ollparish.info).

**OLL Parish defines a parishioner as:**

**REGISTERED:** Any individual or family who filled out a parish census form or some written document declaring membership in our parish that has been accepted by the Pastor.

**ACTIVE:** Individual or family who is regularly in attendance of Mass on Sunday and Holy days of Obligation. This individual or family also takes an active part in parish activities.

**SUPPORTING:** The individual or family who is a regular financial contributor to the parish. To qualify in the parish, a minimum of \$400 annually must be donated to the Church in the previous calendar year.

### **RAS-OLL**

#### **Registered, Active, Supporting of Our Lady of the Lake Parish -**

The school is provided with a list from the OLL Parish Administration Office listing RAS families of OLL. These families meet the requirement set by OLL Parish of contributing \$400 to OLL Parish per calendar year.

Support Fee: Absorbed by OLL Parish - \$300 per student

### **RAS-OTHER**

#### **Registered, Active, Supporting of Parishes other than Our Lady of the Lake -**

For those worshipping and supporting parishes other than Our Lady of the Lake, Parish Affiliation Vouchers verifying that the Parent/Family is "Registered, Active, and Supporting" in their HOME PARISH are to be acquired from your Parish Office and turned in with the registration form. One voucher per child is required. If the voucher did not accompany the registration form, **the form must be turned in immediately to the school office and we will attach them to the appropriate registration form. The deadline for accepting this form is March 1st.** This voucher indicates the HOME PARISH agrees to provide financial support to the PARENT by paying the "Parish Support Fee" to the ATTENDING SCHOOL.

Support Fee: Family obtains from their Home Parish a voucher\* for each student represented, the Home Parish will be responsible to the Archdiocese for the \$300 per student support fee. Deadline for voucher to be received at OLL School - March 1st. OLL school receives the support fee directly from the Archdiocese. **All vouchers must be signed and approved by the Pastor.**

#### **Not listed as Registered Active Supporting of any Parish**

Support Fee: Parent pays to the school the \$300 per student support fee which will be included on the school tuition financial form.
